- 2. Make a list of all the animals you see in one day at or near your house. Write a story about one of them.
- 3. Make a list of all the birds you see each day at your house for a week. Look them up in a bird identification book and learn about them. A book I like is A Field Identification, Birds of North America, a golden Field guide from St. Martin's Press, by Chandler s. Robbins, et.al. Check your library for more books.
- 4. Make a list of birds that live in different habitats. Read about habitats and birds on line:
